# ASTech Awards 2023 - Standard Process Nomination Form

The 34th Annual Alberta Science, Technology, and Leadership Awards (ASTech - astech.ca) showcases Alberta achievements that have made a significant impact through Science or Technology - by furthering discovery, innovation, knowledge, application, adoption, or community.

This Standard Process Nomination Form is to be used for all the 2023 ASTech Awards - (Event Date: Friday, November 3rd, 2023)

 Note: As always - ASTech Awards reserves the right to only award the categories where submission standards are met.

#### Standard Process - Submit an Award Nomination: Deadline: August 15, 2023.

- 1. The process is very similar to that of recent years.
- 2. The Standard Nomination Form has room for approximately 3 pages of information and attachments.
- 3. One Nomination Form for Multiple Categories: Only One (1) Nomination Form is Needed per Nominated Candidate (can be a Company, Team, or Individual), even if they are being Nominated for multiple awards. The form allows multiple award category check-boxes so that worthy Candidates can be considered for multiple categories in this single form submission (ie. Outstanding Woman in Innovation AND Outstanding Health Innovation). Note1: Should the Nominator or Nominee choose, separate Nomination Forms are Allowed Per Category they choose to submit. Note2: A maximum of 5 categories can be selected per project/submission. (If more than 5 categories are selected, only the first 5 will be considered).

#### **Overall Sequence:**

- Submission Stage: Standard Process Nomination Form to be completed by the deadline - August 15, 2023.
- 2. *Judging Stage*: All Completed Full-Nominations are reviewed by our Judges. Finalists in each category are notified and are invited to attend the 2023 ASTech Awards.
- 3. *Award Stage*: Finalists will be recognized prior to, during, and post-event. Award winners will be announced at the annual ASTech Awards Event on November 3, 2023.
